Rugby League Player Protection

*"Sickness and Injury insurance for Footy Players"*

RLPP will provide players with a monthly income if they are unable to work due to sickness or injury (including injuries suffered on the field). Ask yourself – if you could not work and lost your income tomorrow, would you be able to pay your bills and meet your daily living expenses including your mortgage, rent, school fees, groceries, phone bill, etc?

How can a Rugby League player benefit from RLPP?

- Up to 75% of their gross income will be replaced
- Up to 3 months pay upfront for certain injuries even if you return to work the next day!

## Case Study

John Smith:

- is 27 years old and is a Full time Builder,
- is a Smoker / Non-smoker, and
- earns a gross income of \$4,000 per month



John breaks his tibia (leg) during a game of football. He is no longer able to perform his duties as a builder and he is off work for 12 weeks. If John is covered by RLPP, he can potentially receive:

- 2 months of his wages upfront (ie \$8,000), and
- 8 weeks of pay over the period he is away from work (ie. \$8,000),

**This is a total payout benefit of \$16,000 over the 12 week period!**

Cover can cost as little as \$0.50 per day (after tax concessions).
